

Commercial Structure Fire September 5, 2009

On 09/05/2009 at 04:14:00 Fayette County 911 dispatched The Uniontown Fire Department to 261 N Gallatin Avenue in the City of Uniontown. The location is a unoccupied convenience store. The Initial report was a structure fire in a commercial building at above location. Uniontown Police Department marked on scene reporting heavy smoke showing from the entire structure. 40engine One marked on scene with a working fire. 40engine3 placed a 5" supply into service from the hydrant at Askern Street and N. Gallatin Ave. Two 1 3/4" hand lines were placed into service with an interior attack from the A side front door. A quick knock down was completed with extensive overhaul of the entire structure. 40 Truck 1 was placed into service A side for roof top ventilation, 40 Truck 2 was positioned at the rear of the structure. The overhang on the front of the building was also removed and checked for extension of the fire. The owner was notified and was on scene. The PSP Fire Marshall was notified and also Det. Gmitter of the Uniontown Police.
